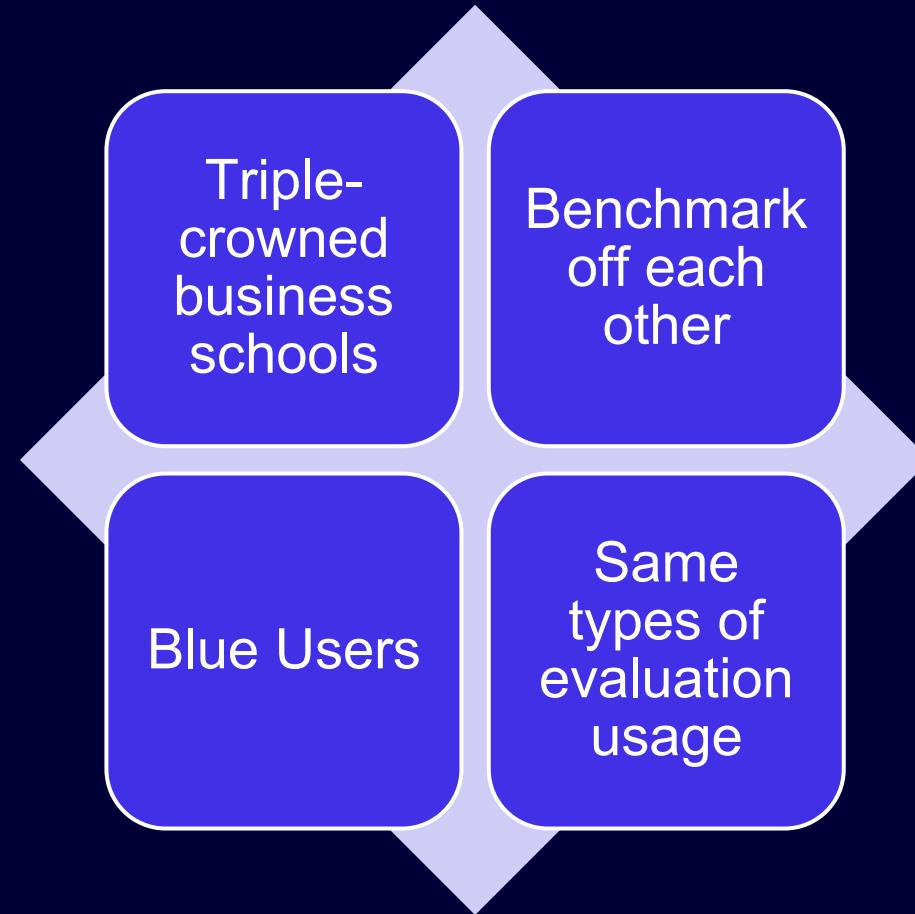

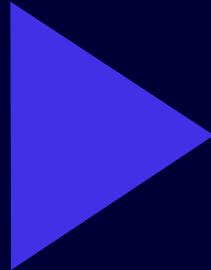
Commonalities

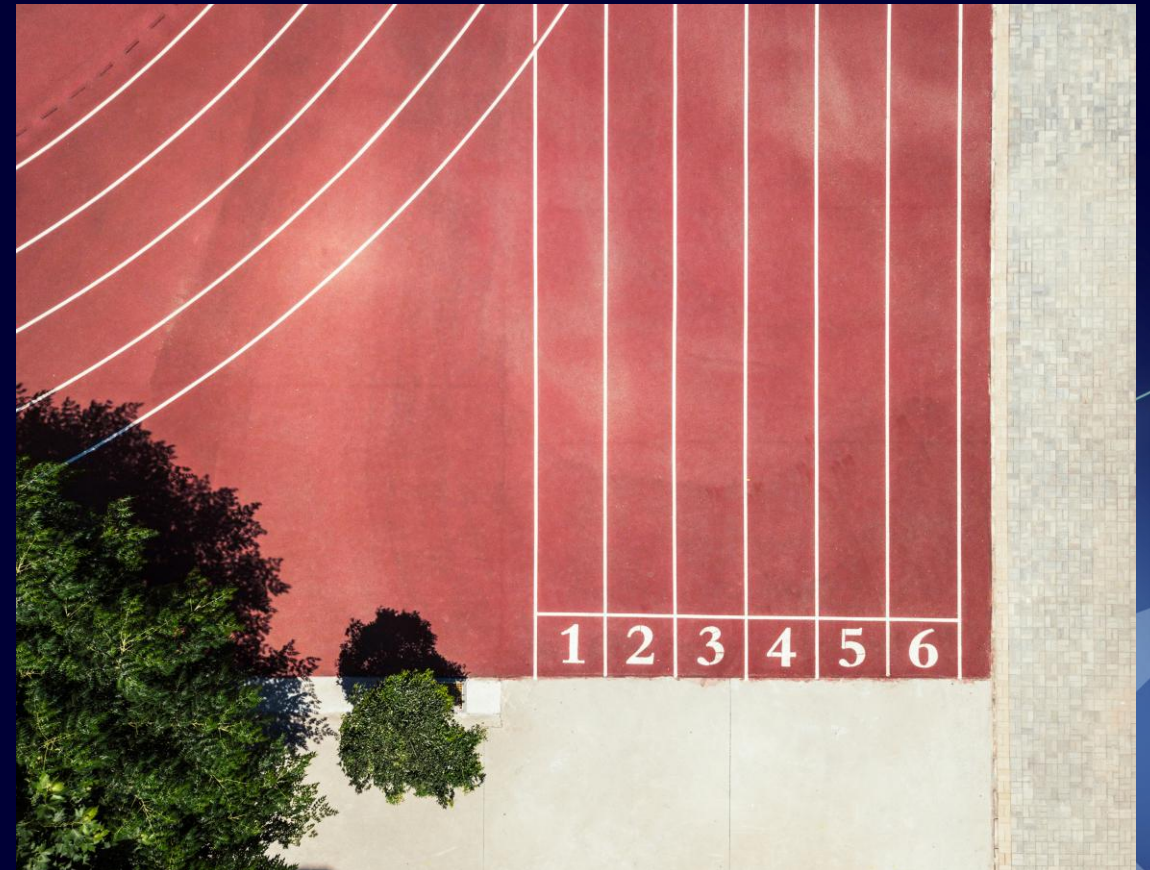

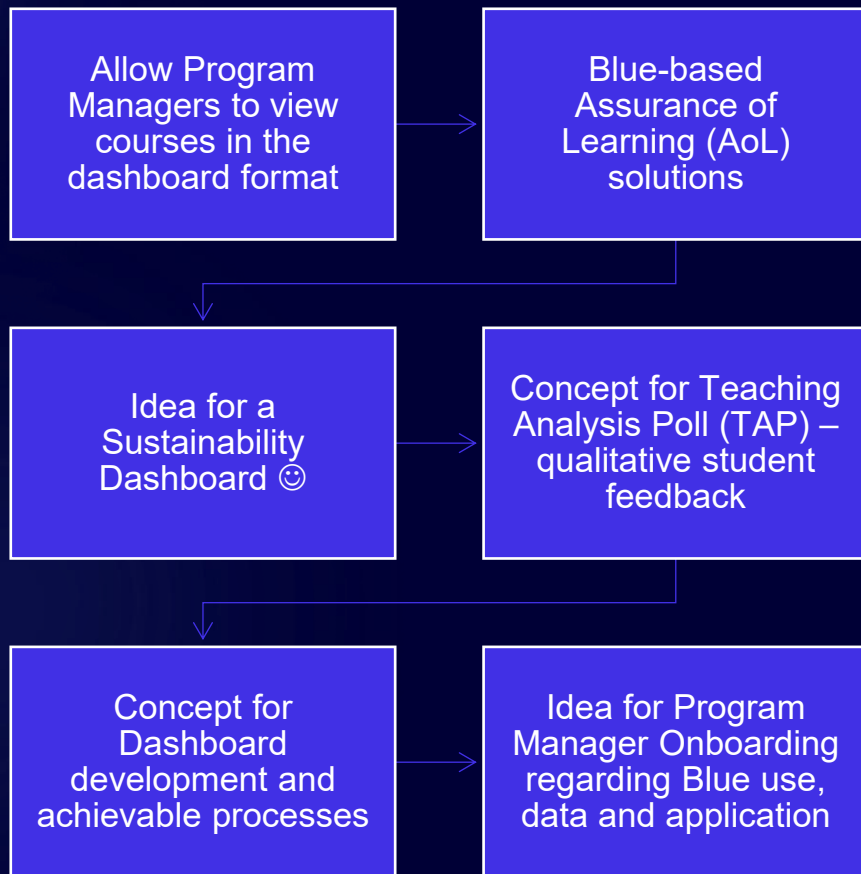

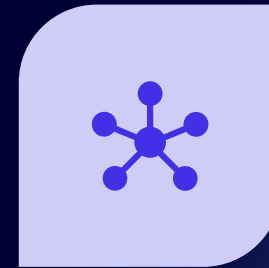
